

## “Ribbon Woobie Baby Blanket”

Surprise the future baby among your family and friends with a soft, engaging blanket that will be their favorite companion!

### Supplies:

Baby Lock Lauren serger  
Baby Lock sewing machine (optional)  
½ yard minky fabric  
½ yard fleece  
Variety of ribbons cut to 4”-5” lengths  
All-purpose thread  
Hand sewing needle  
Cutting mat  
Rotary cutter



### Instructions:

1. Cut your minky and fleece fabrics into a 18” x 18” squares. Set the minky fabric aside.
2. Determine the right-side of the fleece fabric. Fold the ribbons in half and pin them around the edge of the right-side of fleece. Be sure to pin them so the ends of the ribbon align with the edge of the fleece.
3. Pin the minky fabric to the fleece fabric, right-sides together. You've created a sandwich of fleece-ribbon-minky.
4. Serge around each of the four sides, be sure to leave a small opening on one side to turn the blanket right-side out.
5. Turn the blanket right-side out.
6. Hand sew the opening closed.
7. To create a nice edge finish on the blanket, top stitch around the entire square about ¼” inside the edge. This will hold everything together and give a nice finished look.
