

No-Sew Mardi Gras Mask

Head to the parade and jump on the float! With this mask you are more than ready for Mardi Gras!

Supplies:

2 Fat quarters, coordinating prints
9" x 12" piece of Firm-Flex™ Double-sided fusible

1/4" dowel rod, cut to 18"

Assortment of 1/4" ribbon

Assortment of crystals

Crystal Applicator Wand

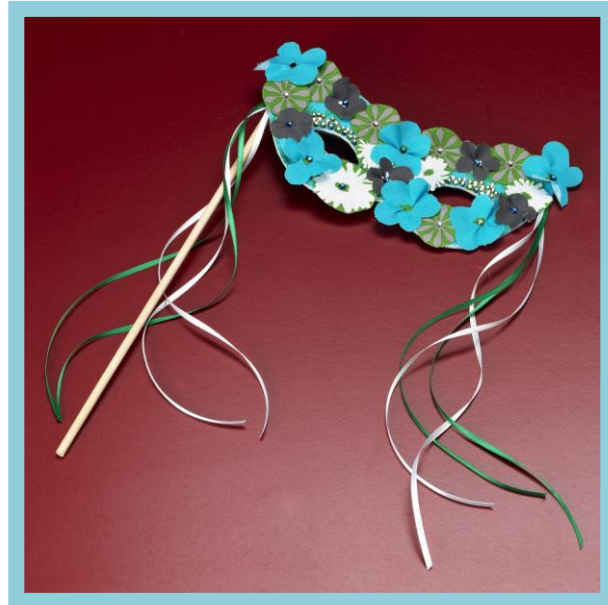
Scissors

Air Erasable Fabric Marker

Print the attached pattern

Tacky glue

Hot glue gun w/glue



Instructions:

1. Cut fabric to the size of the Firm-Flex. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse wrong side of fabric to the Firm-Flex. Fuse fabric on both sides of the Firm-Flex.
2. Trace the mask onto the fabric, using the pattern included with the project.
3. Cut out the mask making sure to cut out the eyes.
4. Cut free-style flowers from the remaining fabrics.
5. Glue them to the mask using tacky glue. Take a little pinch in the center to give them more texture on the mask.
6. Embellish the mask as desired with crystals. FYI...the crystals look really nice around the eyes.
7. Cut several long pieces of ribbon to make streamers for each side of the mask. Glue to each side with the tacky glue.
8. Using the hot glue gun, glue the stick to the side of the mask.

Head to the parade and jump on the float! You are ready for Mardi Gras!
