

## Bath Time Hoodie

**Got kids? Calling all children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews! This Bath Time Hoodie is quick and easy to sew up for those special children in your life. Make bath time really special.**

### Supplies:

Baby Lock embroidery/sewing machine with a 5" x 7" hoop or larger

Amazing Designs: ADC-160 Nursery Décor  
Designs used from the collection: NURS101, NURS102, NURS104, NURS106, NURS110

Full size bath towel

Washcloth to match the bath towel

Madeira Rayon machine embroidery thread  
1.8 oz. Medium Tear-Away stabilizer: ADS-7818S or ADS-7818L

Wash-Away Light Weight Water Soluble

Topping: ADS-3036S or ADS-3036L

Temporary Spray adhesive

Sewing thread to match towel colors



### Instructions:

Print out the templates for the designs listed in the Designs used from the collection information. To do this, place the Nursery Décor CD in the CD drive and run Edit Express software from the CD. Open each design and print out a template.

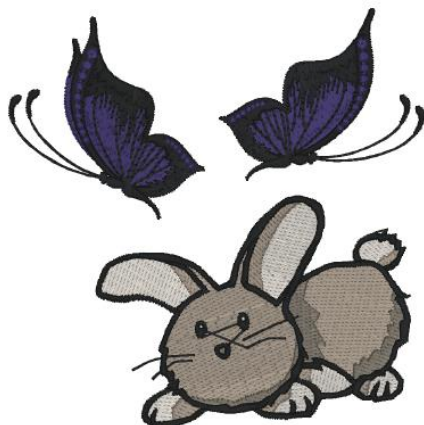
Note: For embroidery machines with only a 4" x 4" design size, you will need to re-hoop the towel for each design.

For embroidery machines that have 5" x 7" hoop size or larger, simply combine the designs on the machine screen.

### Washcloth:

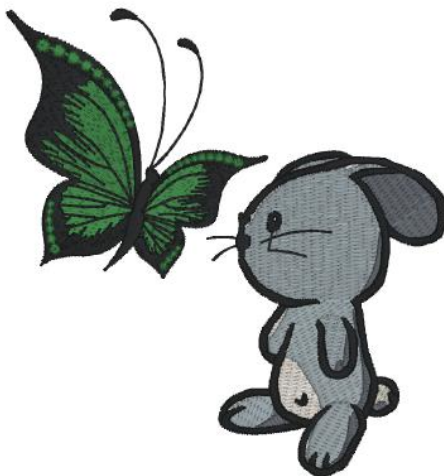
1. Fold washcloth in half then move one edge to be 1" above the other.
2. Fold the shorter half of the washcloth in half again to find the center placement for the embroidery design. Mark the center with a straight pen or marking pen.

3. Hoop a piece of stabilizer then spray with the Temporary Spray Adhesive. Place the center marking on the washcloth in the center of the hoop. Press the washcloth to the stabilizer.
4. Open design NURS101 on the machine screen, then open NURS104 and place above the first design.
5. Place a piece of the Wash-Away Water Soluble Topping on top of the washcloth where the design will be sewn.
6. Sew out the design onto the washcloth.



#### Bath Towel:

1. Hoop a piece of stabilizer then spray with the Temporary Spray Adhesive. Place the design template for NURS110 along the edge of the towel.
2. Place the towel on the stabilizer centering the design in the hoop.
3. Open design NURS110 on the machine screen. Open the design NURS110 again if you have a large hoop that can accommodate more than one design.
4. Place a piece of the Wash-Away Water Soluble Topping on top of the towel where the designs will be sewn.
5. Embroider the flower design along the edge of both towel ends.
6. On the machine screen combine designs NURS102 and NURS106.



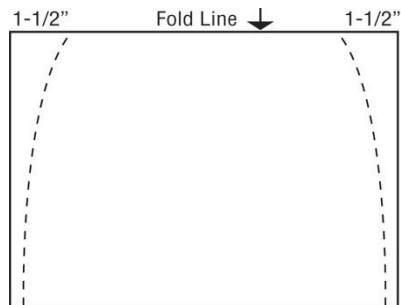
7. Mark the center of the design placement approximately 8" from the end of the towel and 5" from the bottom of the towel.
8. Hoop a piece of tear-away stabilizer and spray with the Temporary Spray

Adhesive.

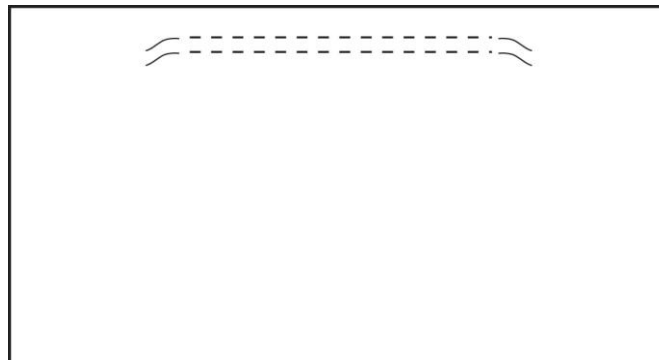
9. Center the design area in the hoop and press the towel in place.
10. Place a piece of Wash-Away Water Soluble Topping on top of the towel where the design will be sewn.
11. On the left side of the towel, the design will need to be flipped horizontally on the machine screen to face the bunny and butterfly in the opposite direction.
12. Remove the stabilizer from the top of the towel and the underside of the towel.

Sewing the Hoodie to the towel:

1. With right sides together fold the washcloth in half but leave the back 1" longer than the embroidered front.
2. Sew the sides together curving in toward the fold about 1 1/2".



3. Turn the hood inside out.
4. Find the center of the top long edge of the bath towel. Measure 6" on each side of center and place straight pins for marking.
5. Set your sewing machine on straight stitch with the longest stitch length.
6. Straight stitch two rows 1/4" apart between the pins on the towel. (Do not use the auto trimmer if you have it on your sewing machine.)



7. Pulling on the thread tails, slightly gather the towel to fit onto the bottom edge of the hoodie.
8. Pin the back edge of the hoodie to the gathered area of the towel.
9. Sew in place with a normal stitch length. To secure the hood to the towel sew two rows of straight stitching 1/4" apart.

Enjoy bath time with the hoodie towel!
