

Inked to the Max Sweatshirt

The guy in your life; whether young or old; will love the trendy style these designs from the Embroidered Ink collection by [Amazing Designs](#) add to any plain hooded sweatshirt.

Supplies:

Baby Lock Ellure Plus or machine with a 130mm x 180mm embroidery field
Embroidered Ink—ADC-158J
Ready-made Hooded sweatshirt
Rinse Away-Tear Away stabilizer
Temporary spray adhesive
Small and medium hoops
Air Erasable Fabric Marker
Ruler
Small Scissors
Assortment of Madeira embroidery thread



Instructions:

1. Browse the design collections and determine the designs you would like to use. Designs TAT103, TAT117 and TAT122 were used in the sample/
2. Print a template for each design used. If you think you might use this design more than once, print it or copy it more than once. This makes it easier to determine the design placement.

Note: Print a couple of the design mirror imaged as well. It will give you additional placement options.
3. Trim the excess paper from around the design but do not trim too close, you don't want to cut off the printed cross hairs as you will need these for marking the placement.
4. Place the templates on the sweatshirt creating the layout. Using the air erasable marker, mark the placement of the first 1-2 designs.

5. Load the first design onto your machine. Hoop the tear-away stabilizer in the appropriate hoop and spray with temporary spray adhesive (some designs in this collection require the 130mm x 180mm hoop).
6. Attach the sweatshirt to the stabilizer, centering the placement markings for the first design into the hoop.
7. Stitch the design. Remove from hoop and tear away the excess stabilizer.
8. Repeat these steps to stitch each of the designs onto the sweatshirt.

Note: You can use the printed templates to modify the layout as the design develops!

This hooded sweatshirt has been “inked” and it ready to go!
