

## St. Patrick's Day Coasters



**With a few fabric scraps, a little embroidery, and a decorative trim, it is possible to create a unique coaster set for any occasion.**

### **Supplies:**

Baby Lock Sewing and Embroidery Machine

[Enlighten](#) or Imagine Wave Serger

Shamrock Embroidery Design in PES Format (included in download)

1/4 yd cotton velveteen

1/4 yd cotton batting or a low loft polyester batting

Stabilizer for embroidery -medium weight tear away

Fabric Spray adhesive

Embroidery thread for embroidery design

Polyester thread for bobbin

1 cone polyester thread for the serger

1 spool Woolly Nylon™

1 spool decorative serger thread such as Pearl Crown™ by YLI

Scissors

Rotary Cutter, Mat & Ruler

### **Instructions:**

1. Save the downloaded Shamrock Embroidery Design

- (ShamrockEmbroideryDesign.PES) Transfer the design to the machine.
2. Thread the Embroidery machine with green embroidery thread in needle and bobbin thread in bobbin. Select the embroidery design.
  3. Hoop the fabric and stabilizer. Stitch out the embroidery design. Remove the stabilizer and press from the wrong side of the fabric.
  4. Repeat this process to stitch out four designs. The coasters will be cut into 6" x 6" squares. Make sure to provide enough room for each design.
  5. Cut out coaster backs, 6" x 6". Cut out batting pieces the same size.
  6. Spray the batting with the fabric adhesive and sandwich the batting between the coaster top and bottom, making sure that the right side of the fabric is facing up.
  7. Following the quick reference sheet, set the Enlighten/ Imagine Wave serger for the Wave stitch using the decorative thread in the upper looper and the wooly nylon in the lower looper.
  8. Stitch around the four sides of each coaster leaving a thread tail at each corner.
  9. Using a double-eyed needle or tapestry needle thread the thread tails into the bottom portion of the stitch.
10. Set out and enjoy!
