

## Modified Triple Easy Table Runner

There's still time to create something new for your 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration. This table runner is quick and easy to assemble. If you have a bit of extra time, add embroidery for personal touch.

### Supplies:

[Baby Lock](#) Ellure Plus or machine with a 130mm x 180mm embroidery field  
Edit Express on the CD with the design collection

[Amazing Designs](#) American Spirit Design Collection—ADP-49

1/2 yard each of three coordinating fabrics

1/2 yard batting

Tear Away Stabilizer

Medium Hoop

Air Erasable Fabric Marker

Ruler

Rotary Cutter

Small Scissors

Assortment of Madeira embroidery thread

### Instructions:

1. From the fabrics, cut the following:

- **Fabric A:** Center panel and corner squares  
Cut center panel – 9" x 10 1/4"  
Cut 4 corner squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- **Fabric B:** Center panel, inner border, and binding  
Cut center panel – 9" x 10 1/4"  
Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x WOF (width of fabric)  
Sub cut each strip into 1-1 1/2" x 30" and 1-1 1/2" x 11"  
Cut 3 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for the binding

- **Fabric C:** Center panel, outer border  
 Cut center panel – 9” x 10 1/4  
 Cut 3 strips 2 1/2” x WOF  
     Sub cut 2 strips into 2-2 1/2” x 32”  
     Sub cut the remaining strip into 2-2 1/2” x 11”

2. Browse the Amazing Designs American Spirit design collection and determine the designs you would like to use. Designs SWNAS103, SWNAS108, SWNAS111, SWNAS123 and SWNAS124 were used in the sample.
3. Print a template for each design used. If you think you might use this design more than once, print it or copy it more than once. This makes it easier to determine the design placement.
4. Trim the excess paper from around the design but do not trim too close, you don't want to cut off the printed cross hairs as you will need these for marking the placement.
5. Place the templates on the center panel to create the layout. Using the air erasable marker, mark the placement of the designs. Remember, when creating your layout to leave a 1/4" seam allowance around the outside of each of the center panels.
6. Load the first design onto your machine. Hoop the tear-away stabilizer in the appropriate hoop and spray with temporary spray adhesive.
7. Attach the center panel to the stabilizer, centering the placement markings for the first design into the hoop.
8. Stitch the design. Remove from hoop and tear away the excess stabilizer.
9. Repeat these steps to stitch each of the designs onto the center panels.  
 Note: You can download the free [Pledge of Allegiance](#) design to use in the center of your table runner.
10. When the embroidery is finished, sew the three center panel pieces together to create a panel 9” x 30”.
11. Sew the 1 1/2” x 30” strips to the sides of the center panel; sew 1 1/2” x 11” strips to the top and bottom.
12. Sew the 2 1/2” x 32” strips to the sides of the unit, sew a 2 1/2” square to each end of the 2 1/2” x 11” strips; sew these three piece units to the top and bottom.



13. Using the remaining fabric to piece the backing into and 18" x 38" rectangle.

14. Layer the top, batting, and backing; quilt as desired; bind.

Put this runner on your table and let the festivities begin!
