

Baby Snuggle Blanket and Matching Burp Cloth

Recently, I have been invited to numerous baby showers. I prefer to give a gift that is personal and unique. This tag blanket is perfect for babies. You can attach a toy to the ribbon and then attach it to the car seat so they never lose it. It looks great with their name or initial in the corner of the blanket.

Supplies:

Baby Lock Sewing/Embroidery Machine - Estante

1/2 yard minky/plush fabric of your choice

1/2 yard coordinating satin

2 yds. of 4 different patterns of ribbon (8 yds. total)

Cloth diaper

Cut Away or Tear Away Stabilizer

Temporary spray adhesive

All-purpose thread & embroidery thread

Scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut 1-16" x 16" piece of minky fabric and 1-16" x 16" piece of satin.
2. Cut 4-5" pieces of ribbon from each pattern.
3. Set up your machine with matching thread ready in the sewing machine. Lay the ribbon down in the order you want them to be sewn on the fabric.
4. Take the first piece of ribbon and fold in half. Place on minky with ribbon edge lined up with edge of the minky fabric. Sew onto the minky fabric with soft side facing up. Sew 4 ribbons on each side, equally spaced.



5. Once you have sewn on all the ribbons, lay it flat with soft side facing up and put the satin on top with satin side facing down. Pin all the way around.
6. Sew all the way around leaving 2" open for turning. Turn blanket right side out and sew opening closed.
7. Choose a decorative stitch on your sewing machine and sew around all four sides.
8. Cut a 17" x 4" piece of the minky.
9. Set up your machine for embroidery.
10. Cut a piece of cut away stabilizer to fit the 4" x 4" or 5" x 7" embroidery frame. Spray with temporary spray adhesive. Lay minky on top of the stabilizer and press to adhere to the adhesive.
11. Lay water soluble stabilizer on top. This keeps the thread from getting lost down in the minky. Attach the hoop to the machine.
12. Using lettering built into your machine, embroider a name or initial on lower half of minky.
Note: I purchased my font from Apex Embroidery Fonts & Designs.
13. Take the hoop off of the machine. Pull the water soluble off the top. If some still remains use a little water and it will dissolve.

14. Pin the minky to the center of the diaper. Sew together with a zig-zag stitch all the way around the minky fabric. Trim any excess material away from the edges.



Now you have an original baby gift that everyone will love. My advice...Be ready to make another one. I'm sure someone will ask who made it!
