

Posh Puppy Kennel Cover

This design could be created for any holiday, theme or occasion. Perfect for any fashionable pooch!

Skill Level: Basic

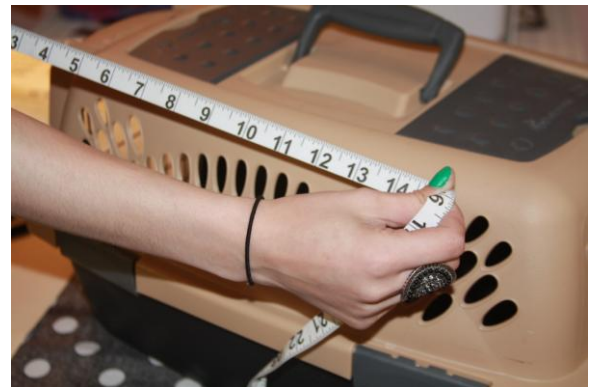

Supplies:

Baby Lock Sewing Machine
 Measure Dog Kennel for fabric yardage (see below)
 Fashion Fabric Quilting Cotton- approximately ½-1 yard
 Cotton Baby Flannel-approximately ½- 1 yard
 Quilting Cotton Fabric for Backing, approximately ½- 1 yard
 Decorative Trim approximately 1 yard
 Fabric marking chalk
 All Purpose Thread
 Tape Measure, Ruler, Pins and Scissors

Instructions:

1. Measure the top of your dog kennel- length and width. Add ½ inch seam allowance all around and cut one rectangle of fashion fabric, one of baby flannel and cut one of fabric backing.
2. Baste baby flannel to the wrong side of your fashion fabric.
3. Mark the opening for the kennel handle by placing the top piece of fabric right side down on the kennel. With chalk lightly draw on the flannel side of your fabric a rectangle around the handle opening on the kennel. Use a ruler to true up your line.
4. Line the top panel, by placing the fabric backing top piece on the fashion fabric right sides together. Pin around the



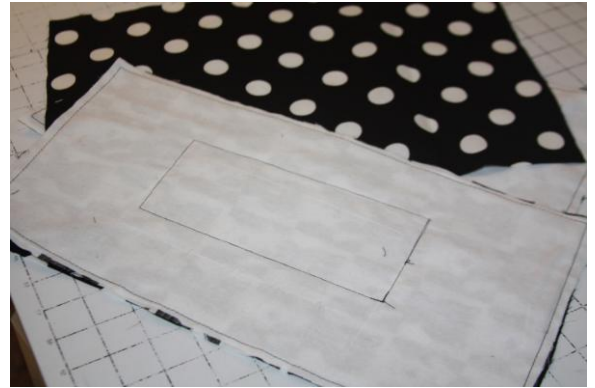
Handle opening square and stitch on this line.

5. Leave ½ inch seam allowance and trip out any extra inside the handle opening rectangle. Clip to but not through each of the 4 corners.
6. Turn the fabric backing to the back side by poking it through the handle opening. Press the opening.
7. Baste around the outer edge of the Kennel top Panel.
8. Repeat steps 1-7 and create 2 Kennel Side Panels. The opening on the sides will allow for air flow so measure against the kennel for the best size.

Finishing:

9. With right sides together, pin each kennel side panel to the long edge on the kennel top panel. Stitch and serge seam.
10. Serge around the entire kennel cover, creating a decorative edge.
11. Add Decorative Trim to lower edge of kennel Side Panels.

Place this over your kennel and you have created a kennel that any posh pooch would be happy to call home!
